FLOORS: charcoal gray slate slabs laid in sheets, aluminum baseboards. **WALLS:** existing walls plastered, plasterboard walls filled smooth and painted. **WALL COLOURS:** white, dark gray in places. **LIGHTING:** lighting plan by Marc Nelson Light Design.

FLOORS: mosaic oak parquet, matt sealed, aluminum baseboards. **FURNITURE:** ATM by Vitra, Plus sideboards by Werner Works. **CEILING:** sound-absorbent units under the hall ceiling.
